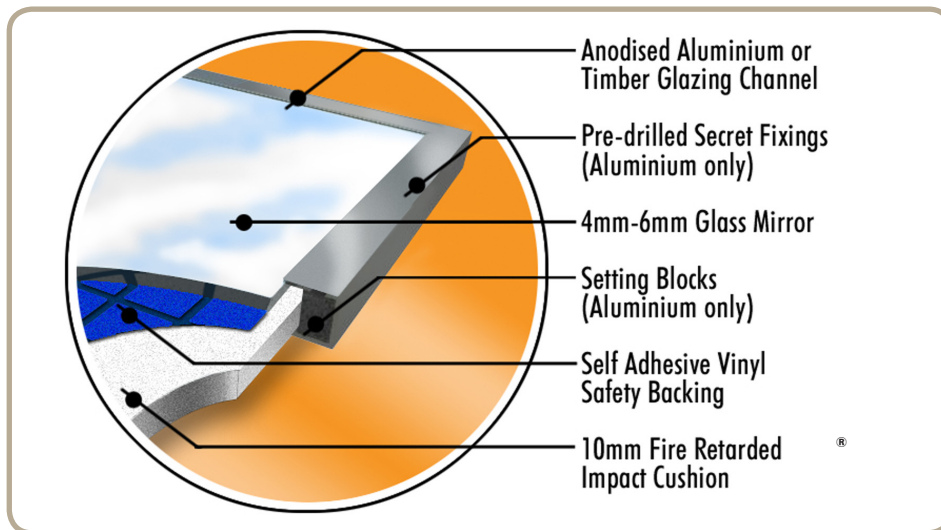

At the same time the system increases the potential for the mirrors to move when you do.

Designed to fit directly onto brick, block or plasterboard walls the vinyl-backed mirror fixed to impact cushion also lessens the need to prepare uneven surfaces behind the mirror.

Tested to BS6206 Class "A" Impact Performance ANSI 297.1 1984 Human Body Impact. Conforms with Australian Standard ASA13666

- **Maximum Panel Size:** 1220 x 3000
- **Nominal Mirror Thickness:** 4mm-6mm
- **Core Material:** Class "A" cross-linked acrylic safety backing.
- **Backing Material:** 10mm thick closed cell fire retarded impact cushion.
- **Method of Fixing:** Secret fixing anodised aluminium glazing channel or timber frame section. Hidden tongue and groove centre fastening system connects mirror to mirror and mirror to wall.
- **Fire Rating:** BS476 Class 0 to both sides.
